This Order only applies to when court is not in session. Staff allowed to perform this service must be on the approved list compiled by the District Court Administrative Office.

For the purposes of Notarizing a Bail Affidavit, any Clerk Commissioned by the State of Rhode Island may sign the Notary Public portion of the affidavit.
