Application for Court Appointment Recertification

Attorneys seeking recertification to court appointment panels must return this form to the **Supreme Court Clerk's Office**, **250 Benefit Street**, **Providence**, **RI 02903**, **every third August 15 following the original certification**. The first recertification for attorneys on the court appointment panels as of April 4, 2025 will be due on August 15, 2028 (see Executive Order 2025-02 on the Judiciary's website at www.courts.ri.gov). If the attorney fails to obtain recertification by August 15 of every third year, then the attorney shall have to complete the original certification process.

A copy of the professional liability insurance policy declaration sheet from your policy **must** be enclosed with your application.

If you do not recertify on a panel and later seek to rejoin that panel, or if you seek to add new panels, then you are required to seek certification, which requires prior approval by the Chief Justice, Presiding Justice, or Chief Judge of the court of appointment.
